The Cloud Bare Metal Backup can make it easier for businesses to back up vApps and virtual machines. From the online control panel, you can, for example, set the frequency and persistence you would like, choose only to recover certain files or clone the virtual machine on a new virtual machine.

The service includes **200 GB of storage space** for each machine, which can be increased if necessary. The backup technology is directly integrated with the hypervisor for the Private Cloud service and with the protection mechanisms offered by VMware to guarantee consistency and performance. There is also native integration with Microsoft VSS to ensure consistency when it





comes to application, and the service can be activated in Italy, France and the Czech Republic, thanks to Aruba's European network of data centers.
