



Global Cloud Data Center has made it to the Cloud Expo Europe in London

Aruba will present the Global Cloud Data Center, the largest data center campus in Italy and one of the largest in Europe, and all the cloud, colocation and hybrid solutions provided by its data center network

To complete it all, the energy used from renewable sources is certified through the certified Guarantee of Origin (GO). All the systems have been designed and built to meet and exceed the highest levels of resilience stipulated by ANSI/TIA 942-A Rating 4 (formerly Tier 4).

Cloud Expo Europe will also be an opportunity to dedicate time to the programme created by Aruba Cloud for startuppers needing training and technological support: known as 'We START you UP', the programme allows you to receive up to € 50,000 free credit, constant technical support and numerous exclusive benefits to promote and launch your business.

Other important international initiatives include the creation of the CISPE - Cloud Infrastructure Services Providers in Europe - an association founded in 2016, of which Aruba is a founding member, which today has more than 20 major cloud infrastructure providers operating in 15 European countries. The CISPE has created a Code of Conduct (CoC) that is in line with the GDPR requirements on data security: the goal is to know in a clear and transparent manner where the personal data of any citizen is located, as well as to standardise regulation in the EU. Aruba's cloud services, such as Private





Cloud, Public Cloud, Cloud Backup and Cloud Object Storage, are identified with a 'CISPE-declared service' trust mark, since they meet the requirements of this code.

Also with a view to data transparency and attention, Aruba is part of the Open Cloud Foundation (OCF), an association of technology companies, with the aim of creating a framework to ensure an open cloud: the aim is to guarantee the freedom to choose client companies and avoid vendor lock-ins.
