

Zaccone gives the Aruba Cloud team its first podium in the MotoE World Championship. Bernardi finishes ninth in a convincing Race-2

On the circuit of Le Mans (France), in front of more than 300k spectators, the Aruba Cloud team conquers its first podium in the MotoE World Championship thanks to the third place of Alessandro Zaccone. After taking Pole Position on Friday, the Italian rider could not get off to the best possible start with his Ducati V21L, but still had the merit of immediately sticking to the podium group to finish third under the chequered flag.

Unlucky, instead, Race-2. On the second lap, Zaccone is involved in Gutierrez's crash, which forces him to retire.

Luca Bernardi's debut in the MotoE World Championship was positive. For the first time in his career at the Le Mans circuit, the number 19 progressed session after session by closing in P13 in Race-1 and then taking his first points in the world classification in Race-2 with ninth place.

Alessandro Zaccone (Aruba Cloud MotoE #61)

"I am thrilled to have left my signature on the first podium achieved by the team. At the same time, however, the regret remains for not completing the round the best way. Unfortunately, I was involved in an accident that was impossible to avoid. However, we must look ahead: we are doing an excellent job with the team that gives us great confidence".

Luca Bernardi (Aruba Cloud MotoE #19)

"In Race 1, I couldn't find a good feeling with the bike. I didn't get a good start, and I struggled a lot. However, we did well with the team, allowing me to find confidence. It's a new adventure for me, and I need to progress round after round."
